Climate change is already affecting the world's poorest and most vulnerable people, who often lack the robust systems and capacity needed to cope. Changes in climate- temperature increase, increased greenhouse gas emissions, altered patterns of precipitation etc are adversely affecting the water and land resource, agriculture and forestry, biodiversity and ecosystem in general and also contributing to various disasters like drought, flooding, crop infestation etc.

Hence it is equally important to educate communities on possible reasons and impacts of climate change and empower them to adapt to climate change.

Need:

It is necessary for field and development practitioners, researchers and academia with the key skills and knowledge to work on the implications of climate change for global and regional development.

This training is specifically designed to understand climate and its impacts and possible mitigation with perspectives to natural resources, agriculture, health, education and livelihoods. The training will enable participants in understanding major climatic patterns in their work area, interpret the impacts of climatic patterns on natural resources and community in general and design climate proofing projects.

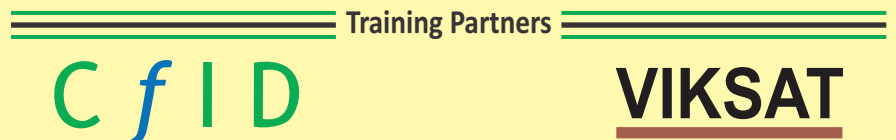
